OPERATORS REPORT

WATER SYSTEMS OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

- 1- April 2016 daily average pumpage 467,000 gallons/day. April 2015 daily average pumpage 468,000 gallons/day.
- 2- The new drive by meter system has arrived and other than the laptop needing to be sent back in. The system itself worked well.
- 3- Repaired leaking water service at 1101 Marietta.
- 4- Tapped water main and directional bored new water service to resident at 407 Lake of the Woods road.
- 5- Tapped water main and installed water service into the barn at Bridle Leash park.
- 6- Graded and seeded water excavations.
- 7- Attended water training class in Arcola.
- 8- Completed shut offs for non-payment, only ten this month.
- 9- Weed control spraying at all facilities.

WASTEWATER SYSTEMS OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

- 1- April 2016 daily average influent to the plant 982,000 gallons/day. April 2015 daily average influent to the plant 710,000 gallons/day.
- 2- Replaced bearing temperature sensor on blower #1.
- 3- Cored drilled sanitary sewer manhole to extend sewer to the barn at Bridle Leash park.
- 4- Grading and rock placement around the old S/A office. And down along the sewer plant fence to control washout.
- 5- Made modifications to the gas chlorine system.
- 6- Pressure washed excess flow clarifier bridge and both IFAS tanks.
- 7- Maintenance performed on the air compressor/dryer.

APRIL MONTHLY REPORT

1. Emptied trash cans on Main Street as needed.
2. Cleaned storm drains as needed while performing windshield survey of streets.
3. Mowed all parks and Village facilities as assigned.
4. Installed repaired pumps at Bridle Leash detention basin.
5. Removed dead animals from ROW as needed.
6. Mowed the greenway and between the river bridges near Barber Park with the bush hog.
7. Repaired a culvert on Prairieview Road.
8. Jetted storm sewers at 112 W. State Street and 801 Clover Drive.
9. Re-sealed catch basins on Oak Valley Road and on Kimela Drive.
10. Held the brush and limb drop-off on April 16th. We are still averaging about 10 people per day.
11. Fabricated a rack for the salt spreader for the pick-up truck.
12. Investigated a possible drainage issue on James Court. There was no Village problem.
13. We have been “spray patching” areas on oil and chip streets where the oil has broken up, so far on the streets to be oil and chipped this year.
14. Filled two trenches with dirt below the river bridges near Barber Park.
15. Re-seeded an area where we dug to repair a storm sewer last fall. We seeded the area in March, but no grass sprouted.

16. Tagged approximately 60 piles of bush and/or leaves to be removed from Village ROW.

SPECIAL EVENTS

1. Assisted with mowing parks and fields.

WATER / WASTEWATER

VEHICLE / EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE

1. Sharpened mower blades as need on rainy days.
