The Village of Mahomet Board of Trustees met, Tuesday June 28, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at the Village of Mahomet Administrative Offices, 503 E. Main St., Mahomet, IL.

ADMINISTRATION:

ORDINANCE 16-06-01, AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF PREVAILING WAGE:

Brown explained this was an annual State requirements. Lynn stated he was disappointed that the mowing had not been done before the event, but added that he had heard good comments concerning Widener and Brown and people thought they were both doing a great job.
