OPERATORS REPORT

WATER SYSTEMS OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

- 1- April 2016 daily average pumpage 467,000 gallons/day. April 2015 daily average pumpage 468,000 gallons/day.
- 2- The new drive by meter system has arrived and other than the laptop needing to be sent back in. The system itself worked well.
- 3- Repaired leaking water service at 1101 Marietta.
- 4- Tapped water main and directional bored new water service to resident at 407 Lake of the Woods road.
- 5- Tapped water main and installed water service into the barn at Bridle Leash park.
- 6- Graded and seeded water excavations.
- 7- Attended water training class in Arcola.
- 8- Completed shut offs for non-payment, only ten this month.
- 9- Weed control spraying at all facilities.

WASTEWATER SYSTEMS OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

- 1- April 2016 daily average influent to the plant 982,000 gallons/day. April 2015 daily average influent to the plant 710,000 gallons/day.
- 2- Replaced bearing temperature sensor on blower #1.
- 3- Cored drilled sanitary sewer manhole to extend sewer to the barn at Bridle Leash park.
- 4- Grading and rock placement around the old S/A office. And down along the sewer plant fence to control washout.
- 5- Made modifications to the gas chlorine system.
- 6- Pressure washed excess flow clarifier bridge and both IFAS tanks.
- 7- Maintenance performed on the air compressor/dryer.

WORK COMPLETED AS OF JUNE 3, 2016**

1. Emptied trash cans on Main Street as needed.
2. Lowered and raised the flags as ordered by the Governor's Office.
3. Advertised and held bid opening for crack sealing.

7. Checked and cleaned storm drains as need while performing windshield surveys.
8. Rented a lift and tightened the straps on the salt shed and fixed two roof leaks on our main building.
9. Straightened a bent culvert at Dunbar Street and Taylor Drive.
10. Lowered a catch basin near 201 S. Division Street.
11. Installed the "Active Duty Military" signs on Main Street.
12. Held interviews for our open full time position.
13. Swept streets in preparation for oil and chip.
14. Sprayed for weeds at the PD garage.
