**ORDINANCE NO. 15-04-02**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MAHOMET VILLAGE CODE, AS AMENDED, TO  
MODIFY THE MINIMUM FINE SCHEDULE FOR ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS OF THE  
VILLAGE OF MAHOMET, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 35 ENTITLED  
“ESTABLISHING THE MINIMUM FINE SCHEDULE FOR ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS”**

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Municipal Code grants municipalities the authority to pass and enforce all necessary police ordinances (65 ILCS 5/1-2-1);

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities have determined that adoption of an ordinance prohibiting certain actions and providing for imposition of a fine for said minor infractions of the law is a necessary police ordinance and shall protect life, health and safety of all persons;

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the Village of Mahomet to adopt an ordinance enforcement system which includes minimum fines and the settlement of certain ordinance violations without filing suit;

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mahomet finds that it is necessary to add additional minimum fines to settle additional ordinance violations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAHOMET, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**Section 1**

Section 35.01(A) of Chapter 35 entitled “Minimum Fine Schedule for Ordinance Violations” is hereby amended in its entirety, so that 35.01(A) shall hereinafter be and read as follows:

(A) The minimum fine schedule for violating certain sections of the ordinances of the village shall be as follows:

Whenever in this Code the doing of any act or the omission to do any act constitutes a violation of any section or provision of this Code, and such section or provision of this Code violated is not listed in section 35.01 and there shall be no fine or penalty declared for such violation, any person who shall be convicted of any such violation shall be fined not less than \$100.00, nor more than \$750.00 for each offense.

**Section 2**

All other provisions and sections of said Ordinance No. 08-07-02, An Ordinance Establishing the Minimum Fine Schedule for Ordinance Violations is re-stated and re-published.

**Section 3**

That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

**Section 4**

This Ordinance shall be in effect 10 days after its passage, approval and publication.
